
Veladoras para el Altar de Día de Muertos Candle Holders for Day of the Dead Altar

As part of an offering to the altar the student can easily create and decorate their own *veladora*. The *veladora* represents the ascension of the spirit a symbol of love that guides the spirit towards the altar. This project will allow the student to use their creativity by decorating the *veladora* with any kind of materials that the teacher provides or materials brought from home. Once completed the student can do a show and tell of their creation to the class, his/her inspiration, meaning, or symbolism. The veladora is one of the most consistent symbols of the altar and is almost always present.
